When Using a Gun Always Follow these NRA Rules:

- 1. Be Sure the Gun is Safe to Operate
- 2. Know How to Use the Gun
- 3. Use Only the Correct Ammunition for the Gun
- 4. Know Your Target and What is Beyond
- 5. Make Sure Downrange Area is Unoccupied
- 6. Wear Eye and Ear Protection as Appropriate
- 7. Never Use Drugs or Alcohol Before or During Shooting
- 8. Guns Should Not be Accessible to Unauthorized Persons

Indoor Range Rules

Only Hand Guns and .22 Caliber Rimfire Rifles on Indoor Range. No Other Long Guns Allowed.

No Black Powder Hand Guns; the Air Exhaust System Will Not Keep Up.

No Center Fire Ammo Over 1000 fps Allowed. Lead Bullets Only, No Shot Shells.

.25 ACP, 32 ACP and 380 ACP May Be Jacketed.

No Center Fire Pistol Targets Hung Below the Red Line.

Clean the Range When You are Finished, Make Sure Lights, Heat, and Air Exhust Fans are Turned Off. When Leaving the Building Make Sure the Door is Locked
